Send a link inviting participants anywhere in the world to join your canvus for remote touch interaction


During a collaboration session users can now easily email an invite to meeting participants elsewhere in the building, working from home, in a client's office, or anywhere from any laptop, tablet, or video wall with Canvus installed. With just a touch you can send a link out for others to instantly join your session for real-time interaction just as if they were in the same room.





Manage and control access across your organization

Different teams within an organization want to use a video wall for different purposes but their saved content may not always be intended for other teams to view or modify. While any user can still walk up to a video wall and start a Canvus session, Canvus 3.0 gives you control of who can access your individual canvases. Now you can manage access and editing rights for different groups of users across an organization from a single dashboard.



ADDITIONAL FEATURES

SINGLE SIGN ON

Users can authenticate to Canvus 3.0 with SAML through an identity provider (IDp) of your choice so nobody needs to remember a new username or password. To skip entering credentials with a keyboard, Canvus 3.0 also allows authentication using a mobile device by scanning a QR code on the screen.

PERSISTENT WEB BROWSER SESSIONS

Web browser sessions on each canvas now persist for each user so there's no need to re-login to any web services you use within Canvus. Additionally, the starting page and default search URL for web browsers can now be configured in the Canvus client.

NEW WEB DASHBOARD

The new web UI for Canvus Connect server allows users to manage access control of their canvases, maintain their personal access tokens for REST API, manage user groups, configure server settings, manage their server license, and access an audit event log which records users' actions on the server.

ENHANCED COPY/PASTE

Use CTRL-C/CTRL-V with a physical keyboard, undo/redo text entered in input fields, and improved text selection.



NEW USER INTERFACE

The interface has been optimized to make Canvus even easier to use on a video wall, laptop, or any standard device using fingers or mouse and keyboard. Improved keyboard focus makes it easier to use both the virtual and physical keyboard. Windows Tablet mode settings are now supported for devices with detachable keyboards.

WELCOME SCREEN & DEFAULT CANVUS

The new welcome screen improves workspace state management and users can now specify a default canvas for each client that is accessible from the welcome screen.

ADDITIONAL ENHANCEMENTS
